
RIGHT SIDE OF FABRIC



BACK SIDE OF FABRIC

SEWING A BABY HEM AKA DESIGNER HEM


Press up $\frac{1}{4}$ " (6mm) on lower edge. Stitch close to pressed edge. Trim close to stitching. Press under $\frac{1}{8}$ " (3mm) and stitch in place.



SEWING NARROW HEMS

Press up %" (1.5cm) narrow hem at lower edge, turning in raw edge to meet the crease.

Stitch in place.




SEWING A NARROW HEM WITH EASE

To hem lower edge, machine baste $\frac{1}{4}$ " (6mm) from raw edge using long machine stitches, as shown.

Press up a %"(1.5cm) narrow hem on lower edge, turning under raw edge on line of basting.

Pull thread to ease in fullness.

Stitch in place.


SEWING NARROW HEM WITH CORNERS

Press up %" (1.5cm) narrow hem at lower edge of fabric piece.

Open out and turn under corners diagonally where crease lines cross.

Trim corner to ¼" (6mm). Turn in raw edge to meet crease.

Press. Stitch in place.




SEWING A NARROW HEM WITH SQUARE SLIT OPENING

Press in %" (1.5cm) on side and lower edges of fabric piece.

Open out and turn under corners diagonally where crease lines cross. Trim corner to $\frac{1}{4}$ " (6mm).

Turn in raw edge to meet crease, tapering to nothing above top of opening. Stitch hem in place, squaring stitching above opening.




SEWING NARROW HEM WITH CURVED SLIT OPENING

Machine-baste $\frac{1}{4}$ "(6mm) from curved raw edge, using long machine stitches, as shown.

Press up a %"(1.5cm) narrow hem on lower and side opening edge, turning under raw edge to meet the crease.

Pull thread to ease in fullness.

Stitch in place, squaring stitching above opening.



SEWING NARROW HEM WITH FACING

Turn facing to outside. Stitch $\frac{5}{8}$ " (1.5cm) from lower edge of facing. Trim as shown.

Turn facing to inside, pressing up %" (1.5cm) narrow hem at lower edge.

Turn in raw edge to meet the crease.

Stitch in place.
